Matthew 3:13-4:17

The main idea of Matthew 3:13-4:17:

God the Father affirms His Son at His baptism, God the Spirit leads the Son to be tempted and God the Son brings the light of the Gospel to the darkness.

Discussion questions:

How can you tell people about Jesus?

What is the significance of Jesus' baptism?

What was the purpose of Jesus' temptation?

At the baptism of Jesus, what did the people see and hear and how did this clarify who Jesus was?
